A total of 8 children on current role are eligible for Pupil Premium funding. Currently 5 children are eligible for free school meals

Children who are eligible for free school meals remain eligible for Pupil Premium funding for six years.

Children whose parents are members of the Military Services are also eligible for reduced Pupil Premium funding.

For the financial year 2014-15 we will be in receipt of £17,920, paid in three termly payments. This is based on 19 children eligible in Spring 2014.

A number of children eligible for Pupil Premium funding also fall into other categories, including children with SEND.
